Scholarship Criteria

1. The recipient must be a citizen of the United States of America and enrolled as a full-time student in an engineering program at a university/college that has been accredited by the Engineering Accreditation Commission of the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET-EAC).
2. The candidate must have a least one academic semester or its equivalent remaining of undergraduate work.
3. Nominees will be considered on the basis of the information provided within the application.
4. Though not a requirement, preference may be given to:
 - a. A relative to an employee at an ACEC-RI member firm.
 - b. A permanent Rhode Island resident.
 - c. Candidates enrolled in a civil engineering, environmental engineering or other construction related program, though students of all engineering curriculums are eligible.
