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Firm Eligibility:

The competition is open to any ACEC-RI full member firm, ACEC-RI affiliate member firm, and/or any ACEC-RI affiliate firm engaged in the practice of consulting engineering in Rhode Island.

Project Eligibility:

Eligible projects must have been built in Rhode Island or, if the project is located outside of Rhode Island, the majority of the design work must have been performed in Rhode Island. Only constructed projects that have been substantially completed and are ready for use between December 1, 2020 and December 31, 2022 are eligible. Projects will compete with similar-sized projects in two categories: Under \$10 Million and Over \$10 Million.

Why Enter?

By entering, your firm is making a statement that you aspire to the achievement of excellence in the engineering profession. You are also contributing to the advancement of the profession by sharing your experiences applying innovative best practices and designs to better serve the clients and communities of Rhode Island. All award winners will receive recognition at the ACEC-RI Annual Meeting in June, on the ACEC-RI website, and in press releases to local and industry publications.

National Competition:

Award Finalists are eligible but not required to submit to the ACEC national competition. See www.acec.org for submission details.

Rating Guidelines for Judging:

Built projects will be evaluated based on the following five weighted criteria:

- 30% - Successful fulfillment of the owner/client's needs
- 20% - Social, economic or sustainable design considerations
- 20% - Uniqueness and/or innovative applications of new or existing techniques
- 20% - Value to the engineering profession and perception by the public
- 10% - Complexity

Dates to Remember:

- May 19, 2023: Applications Due
- June 5, 2023: Finalists notified of eligibility for the national competition in 2024.
- June 22, 2023: ACEC-RI Annual Meeting and Awards Presentation
- January 5, 2024: ACEC National Award Submission Deadline
